- Working to ensure all campers are comfortable, safe, and included;
- Knowing where campers are at all times;
- Performing other duties as assigned;
- Having fun;
- And, most importantly, showing campers the love of Christ.



## “Am I qualified to be a counselor at Camp 1:27?”

To be a counselor at Camp 1:27, you must:

- Have a high school diploma/GED
- Have outdoor skills and ability to reach all physical areas of camp facilities and grounds.
- Be a mature Christian;
- Love and work well with children and youth;
- Facilitate small group, worship, and recreation activities
