placement, and who have been adopted. We also had the largest staff we have ever had. The Lord truly blessed us this summer. We are thankful for everyone who helped make Camp 1:27 happen. Because of your generosity we were able to share the gospel and give 175 campers the best week of their lives.

One of those campers was Amy Dysart. Amy has experienced a hard upbringing. Her biological mom raised her as a single parent and struggled to make ends meet, sometimes resulting in homelessness. She eventually was diagnosed with cancer and was no longer able to give Amy the care she needed so Amy was put into foster care at 14. Amy's first time at camp came after entering foster care and while her mom was dying from cancer. She felt isolated as if she was the only person who had experienced what she had. While at Camp 1:27, Amy was able to meet other people who had experienced similar things in life. When Amy's mom passed away after camp was over, she had a peace within her because of the encouragement and love she felt from the staff and other campers. Amy has continued to come to Camp 1:27 the last seven years. She says Raleigh's Place is her favorite place to visit. She loves the pools, the beautiful land, the big house, and horses. She loves making new friends, socializing, and hearing everyone's stories. Most importantly, she loves hearing God's Word as it is preached and taught throughout the week. She is now 20 years old and is about to be emancipated from DHR custody. She is currently pursuing certification as a patient care technician at Wallace Community College, but her dream is to be an actress.

We are humbled to have had such an influence in Amy's life. We desire to continue having this type of influence on others too.
